CHIEF JUDGE ORDER 2020-10 (FOURTH) AMENDED

RE: RELEASE OF NON-VRA MISDEMEANOR AND NON-DUI/DWAI DEFENDANTS

Any defendant with an active El Paso County or Teller County warrant on a non-VRA misdemeanor or non-DUI/DWAI case for either a failure to appear in court or a failure to comply with probation conditions who is contacted by a law enforcement officer in El Paso or Teller Counties shall have the warrant converted to a PR bond in the same dollar amount or, in the case of a no bond warrant, to a \$3000 PR bond. In addition, the defendant shall be provided a summons return date per the directions on the warrant or a return date on the division's regular docket day.

This policy shall not apply to those cases where the trial judge has specifically indicated that an arrest warrant shall not be converted to a PR bond.
